

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
(HELKS BROW, WRAY, LANCASTER CITY)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2021

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Helks Brow, Wray from at a point approximately 150 metres north west of Helks Brow Farm.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021 until 2359 hours on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2021 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary due to embankment collapse.
